



## Conditions of The Catholic Education Commission of WA Scholarship for Year 12 Graduates from Catholic Schools.

The Catholic Education Commission of WA Scholarship for Year 12 Graduates from Catholic Schools (*Scholarship*) is administered in accordance with the following conditions:

**1. NAME OF SCHOLARSHIP**

The Catholic Education Commission of WA Scholarship for Year 12 Graduates from Catholic Schools.

**2. PURPOSE OF SCHOLARSHIP**

The Catholic Education Commission of WA is funding ten (10) scholarships to high achieving Year 12 students who must have an ATAR score typically 90 or above and wish to pursue teaching as a career.

**3. VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIP**

- a) The overall total of the Scholarship funding is \$2,500 per annum.
- b) The total value of Scholarship over the four year degree is \$10,000.

**4. CONCURRENT SCHOLARSHIPS**

The Scholarship may be held concurrently with other awards.

**5. METHOD OF PAYMENT**

The University will pay the Scholarship funds in two instalments (after the census dates in first and second semesters) to the Fees Office to be offset against the recipient's tuition fees. The recipient will receive \$2,500 per year for a four year duration.

**6. ADMINISTERING BODY**

The Scholarships will be administered by the University Fees Office.

**7. CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP**

- a) The recipient must be a successful graduate of a Catholic School. The recipient must have an ATAR score typically 90 or above.
- b) The recipient must be enrolled to study an Initial Teacher Education program at The University of Notre Dame Australia, Fremantle Campus.
- c) The Scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Dean of the School of Education.

**8. PRIVACY**

The University is committed to the principles contained in the Privacy Act 1988 (Commonwealth) and the Privacy Amendment (Private Sector) Act 2000 (Commonwealth) and will not disclose any personal information (as defined in the Privacy Act) relating to this Scholarship to any third party without the written consent of the applicant.
