3 PURPOSE

These Program Regulations set out the approved requirements for the Bachelor of Arts (Politics & Journalism).

4 OVERVIEW

4.1 Campus Availability

The Bachelor of Arts (Politics & Journalism) has been approved for delivery on the Fremantle and Sydney campuses.

4.2 Student Availability

The Bachelor of Arts (Politics & Journalism) is available for enrolment to domestic Students and international Students with a student visa.

4.3 Australian Qualifications Framework

The Bachelor of Arts (Politics & Journalism) is accredited by the University as a Level 7 AQF qualification.

4.4 Duration

(i) The Volume of Learning for the Bachelor of Arts (Politics & Journalism) is three (3) years of equivalent full-time study.

(ii) An option to complete this Program part-time is available.

(iii) An accelerated option to complete the Program is not available.

4.5 Maximum Duration

The maximum period of time within which a student is permitted to complete the Bachelor of Arts (Politics & Journalism) is eight (8) years (including any periods of approved leave of absence) from the date on which they were first enrolled into the program by the University.

4.6 Study Mode

The Bachelor of Arts (Politics & Journalism) is offered in Internal Study mode.

4.7 Professional Accreditation

There are no professional accreditation requirements applicable to this Program.

5 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5.1 University Admission Requirements

7 PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

7.1 Program Description

The Bachelor of Arts (Politics and Journalism) includes a specialised collection of units drawn from politics, international relations and journalism. The course equips students with a critical understanding of government and politics as well as journalism practices and the evolving media landscape. It is both theoretical and practical. The course develops transferable skills, including the ability to think critically, creatively and ethically, solve problems innovatively, be culturally and globally aware, communicate effectively, and engage in life-long learning.

7.2 Program Learning Outcomes

Upon successful completion of the Bachelor of Arts (Politics & Journalism) graduates will be able to:

- 1 Demonstrate broad theoretical and practical knowledge, with depth in the underlying principles and concepts related to politics, international relations and journalism;
- 2 Identify appropriate sources and evaluate information
- 3 Demonstrate an awareness of different conceptual approaches and/or research methods
- 4 Identify the ethical considerations informing the study and professional practice of politics, international relations and journalism
- 5 Synthesise knowledge and apply skills in order to solve complex political and cultural problems
- 6 Communicate arguments and/or ideas to specialist and non-specialist audiences in a range of forms
- 7 Exemplify the technical and professional skills required in the domains of politics, international relations and journalism
- 8 Work independently and, where appropriate, in collaboration with others
9. Reflect upon personal knowledge, skills and experiences drawn from the study and practice of politics, international relations and journalism.

7.3 Required Courses

To be eligible for the Award of Bachelor of Arts (Politics & Journalism) students must complete a minimum of 600 Units of Credit, which include the following required and elective courses:

- 75 Units of Credit from three (3) Core Curriculum Courses
- 75 Units of Credit from three (3) elective courses, which in Fremantle must include ARTS1000 Academic Writing, Communication and Research
- 200 Units of Credit from three (3) compulsory and five (5) elective Politics and International Relations Courses
- 200 Units of Credit from six (6) compulsory and two (2) elective Journalism Courses
- 50 Units of Credit from one (1) compulsory History Course and one (1) compulsory Business course

7.4 Elective Courses

Any of the following elective Courses may be completed, where prerequisites and admission requirements allow:

- (i) Courses that are offered by the School of Arts and Sciences and listed in Appendix C;
- (ii) Courses taken by cross-institutional enrolment, including Study Abroad, as approved by the Dean; and
- (iii) up to 50 Units of Credit from general electives, including those from other Schools, where prerequisites and admission requirements allow.

7.5 First-Year Courses

Students may not complete more than ten (10) 1000-level Courses in this Program, including those credited by Advanced Standing.

7.6 Honours

The Bachelor of Arts (Politics & Journalism) is offered with Honours. Details are available in the Bachelor of Arts (Politics & Journalism) (Honours) Program Regulations and are to be read in conjunction with the Policy: *The Award of a Degree with Honours*.
