





The University of Notre Dame Australia uses an encrypted wireless network, to ensure that all information is protected.

To access the wireless network, you must have an active staff or student username and password. Access to the university Wi-Fi is granted under the same policies as accessing our wired network.

The following connection to the UNDA-WiFi was tested on a Chromebook with latest updates installed. Some of the terminology and captured screenshot may be different from current version of Chromebook OS.

1. Click the **network icon** in the lower-right corner of your screen. 
2. Select WiFi Network **UNDA-WiFi**

3. Enter the following details to join the network
 - **SSID:** UNDA-WiFi
 - **EAP Method:** PEAP
 - **Phase 2 authentication:** MSCHAPv2
 - **Server CA Certificate:** Default
 - **User Certificate:** None Installed
 - **Identity:** Student/ Staff ID
 - **Password:** Student/ Staff password
 - **Anonymous Identity:** Empty
