UNDERSTANDING YOUR PROGRAM PLANNER: This program planner shows the structure of your courses as they need to be completed across the 3 years. The program has a total of 600 units of credit. **Pre-requisite courses** need to be completed before commencing the next course of your program. **Co-requisite courses** are pre-clinical courses and must be completed in the same semester as the corresponding professional practicum course. **Elective courses** are only available to semester 6 students. Graduates are eligible to apply to AHPRA for general registration as a Registered Nurse Division 1.

CORE COURSE INFORMATION: Students can study core courses as indicated on the program planner or earlier for example in summer term previous to the semester indicated on the planner. First and Second Year students can only enrol to study core courses in Winter Term once clinical practicum dates are confirmed. Third year students cannot study core courses in Winter Term or the final semester of the 3 year degree. All components of the program must be passed in order to complete the degree.
