

School of Nursing and Midwifery, Sydney Bachelor of Nursing (3571)

Specific programs/courses recognised for Advanced Standing

The School of Nursing has articulation arrangements for prospective students who are Enrolled Nurses

Enrolled Nurse (Division 2) are eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Nursing applicants and must meet the following specific requirements:

- Must have completed a Diploma of Nursing (HLT51607, HLT51612, HLT54115) in the previous 8 years that has been accredited with the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Accreditation Council.
- Evidence of registration with Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency as an Enrolled Nurse (Div 2).

Enrolled nurses must be registered with the Nurses and Midwives Board of Australia and have no conditions on their registration.

In the event an Enrolled Nurse (Div 2) has conditions on their registration the credit granted may need to be modified depending on the conditions imposed by the Nurses and Midwives Board.

In addition to the University general regulation there are three criteria that form the basis for decisions about Enrolled Nurses and the credit received into the Bachelor of Nursing:

- Recency of practice
- Registration status
- Enrolled Nurse Qualifications

Enrolled Nurses with a Diploma of Nursing (Enrolled/Division 2 nursing) (HLT51612 or HLT51607 or HLT54115) may receive the following credit:
