At the completion of a student's first year, an application to the School of Law may be made to enroll in a Bachelor of Law.

If successful, the University recommends continuing with the Bachelor of Arts as a second degree in combination with the Bachelor of Law. The Arts electives commenced in the student's first year can then be pursued as a Major in the Bachelor of Arts as a second degree.

If not successful in an application to Law, the student can continue in the Bachelor of Arts, forming a Major from the electives studied in the first year.
