

How to Resubmit Assessment as Part 2 in Turnitin


Academic Integrity Assessment

Blackboard Quick Guide

If you were marked as "Not Yet" for your Academic Integrity assessment after the initial round of marking, you will be given a chance to correct your referencing and resubmit. To accommodate this second submission, your lecturer will be creating Part 2 of the same assessment.

When you open the applicable Turnitin Assessment link, this is what you will see.

Click on **Submit** tab on top left.

Because you already submitted Part 1, **Part 2** should be automatically displayed in the Submission Part box. If not, just select Part 2 via the drop-down arrow menu.

Browse to select the file you are submitting, read and tick the legal **Notice** and click **Submit Paper**.

The parts of the same assessment do not get compared to each other so that the similarity score will remain valid.
