



Conditions of The St Mary MacKillop Award

Mary MacKillop was an exceptionally influential Australian who dedicated herself to education of the needy. On 17 October 2010, Mary MacKillop was canonised as Australia's first saint. This Award was established in recognition of the canonisation of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop.

The awarding of the St Mary MacKillop Award must comply with these Conditions.

1. NAME OF AWARD

The St Mary MacKillop Award.

2. PURPOSE

The St Mary MacKillop Award will be awarded annually to a student who has made an outstanding contribution to the advancement of the Catholic mission and goals of the University. This student will have demonstrated St Mary of the Cross' philosophy of "Never see a need without doing something about it."

3. VALUE OF AWARD

The value of the Award is \$1,000.

4. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for the Scholarship, applicants must:

- a) Be a student of The University of Notre Dame Australia, Fremantle Campus;
- b) Have made an outstanding contribution to the University or community life; and
- c) Have shown determination in the advancement of the Catholic mission and goals of the University.

5. SELECTION COMMITTEE

The successful recipient will be selected based on the advice and recommendations of a selection committee comprising:

- a) The Vice Chancellor (or nominee);
- b) Executive Director of Admissions and Student Services; and
- c) Two Deans from The University of Notre Dame Australia, Fremantle Campus.

6. AWARDING PROCEDURE

The St Mary MacKillop Award is awarded annually The University of Notre Dame Australia, Fremantle Campus Annual Awards Ceremony.

7. METHOD OF PAYMENT

The Award will be paid directly to the recipient by the University by way of direct deposit into a bank account nominated by the recipient.

8. CONCURRENT AWARDS

The Award may be held concurrently with other awards.

9. ADMINISTERING BODY

The Award is administered by the Office of University Relations, Fremantle and the Division of Admissions and Student Services, Fremantle.

10. PRIVACY

The University will collect, use, hold and disclose personal information in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Commonwealth) and the University's Privacy Policy.
