## About the Bachelor of Nursing (Articulation Pathway for EN Diploma)

The Articulation Pathway for Enrolled Nurses with the Diploma of Nursing HLT54115, HLT51612 or HLT51607 into the Bachelor of Nursing program recognises the relevant prior educational achievements of an Enrolled Nurse and offers a reduced number of units in the formal curriculum. This course contains all of the subjects mandated for nursing accreditation in Australia, while placing strong emphasis on clinical experience.

At the cornerstone of the Bachelor of Nursing degree at Notre Dame is a commitment to equip students with the skills and confidence to work in a variety of health care settings upon graduation. This is facilitated by intensive practicum experiences totalling 800 hours throughout the degree. It is envisaged that graduates of this course are capable of providing high quality care in a compassionate, respectful and confident manner.

## Career opportunities

Graduates will be eligible to apply to register with the Nurses and Midwives Board of Western Australia as a Registered Nurse, capable of practising in any area of nursing as a beginning practitioner.

## Course structure

The course uses a blended learning delivery model with units structured:

- › Fully online
- › Online with face-to-face (blended/mixed mode)
- › Intensive week-long blocks on the Broome Campus (core units)

The delivery of a unit will be determined during the enrolment stage for each semester.

### Clinical Practicum

Each semester you will engage in a clinical practicum unit as per the course planner.

**Stage 3:** Total of 200 hours in General/Medical

**Stage 4:** Total of 240 hours in Perioperative and Mental Health

**Stage 5:** Total of 200 hours in Surgical

**Stage 6:** Total of 160 hours in Medical / Surgical / Community / Specialty / Accident & Emergency / RFDS / Remote

## Admission requirements

Admission to The University of Notre Dame Australia is based on the following criteria:

- › Personal qualities, motivation to study and academic potential
- › Contribution to church, school and community life
- › Academic record
- › Interview

### Mature-age minimum academic entry requirements:

Minimum Entry requirement for the articulation pathway is a qualification as an Enrolled Nurse who has completed the Diploma of Nursing (Enrolled-Division 2 Nursing) HLT51607, HLT54115 or HLT51612 and who is currently registered with Australian Health Practitioner Regulatory Authority (AHPRA) will be eligible for prescribed advanced standing to articulate into the Bachelor of Nursing.

## Accommodation
