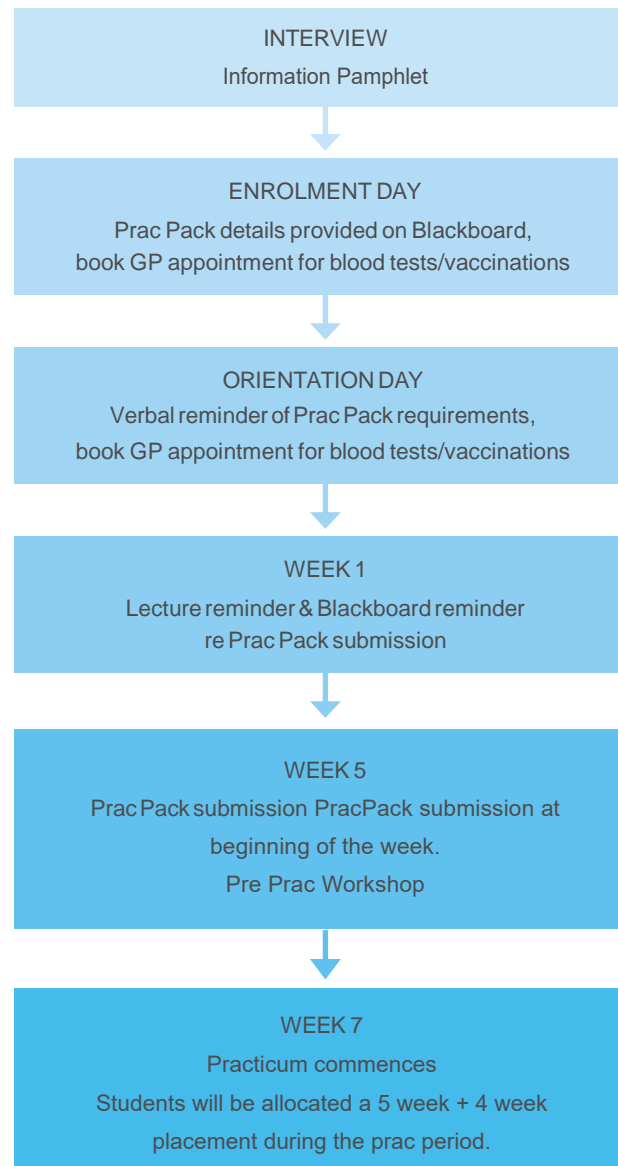
Preparing for Professional Practicum

- › It is mandatory that nursing students provide evidence that they are suitably immunised against blood borne viruses prior to attending any clinical practicum.
- › Each student must also submit evidence of criminal screenings and annual certifications.
- › We refer to the pre requisites as the Clinical Practicum Pack (Prac Pack).
- › Submission of the Prac Pack is a requirement of the Western Australian Department of Health.
- › A placement will not be offered until the Prac Pack is successfully completed.
- › Students will be expected to attend early, late and night shifts.
- › Practicum shifts may occur on any day of the week including public holidays and weekends.
- › You are responsible for organising travel arrangements.
- › Placements may not be available close to home and it will be your responsibility to organise travel arrangements.
- › It is essential that holidays or other arrangements are not finalised until placements have been confirmed.

Details for criminal clearances, certificates and your vaccination requirements are all listed on your Blackboard. Please attend to the pack requirements as soon as possible.

Please be aware that there is a financial cost (approximately \$1000) associated with these requirements. The estimated costs are set by the service providers.

Timeline to Successful Practicum



Immunisation Requirements

Tuberculosis:

- › Results of screening test, known as Mantoux (or Quantiferon)

Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) and Varicella:

- › Evidence of two doses or serological evidence of immunity

Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis:

- › (dTpa) within last 10 years

Hepatitis B:

- › Evidence of first dose, minimum for first clinical placement

Mandatory Training Requirements

Mandatory training is offered to nursing students on campus prior to and during the semester.
