3 PURPOSE

These Program Requirements set out the approved requirements for the Graduate Certificate (Missionary Leadership).

4 OVERVIEW

4.1 Campus Availability

The Graduate Certificate (Missionary Leadership) has been approved for delivery on the Sydney Campus of the Arete Centre for Missionary Leadership.

4.2 Student Availability

The Graduate Certificate (Missionary Leadership) is available for enrolment to domestic Students and international Students with a student visa.

4.3 Australian Qualifications Framework

The Graduate Certificate (Missionary Leadership) is accredited by the University as a Level 8 AQF qualification.

4.4 Duration

The Volume of Learning for the 0.5 years of equivalent full-time study. It is only available in part-time mode, across the entirety of an academic year.

4.5 Maximum Duration

The maximum period of time within which a student is permitted to complete the Graduate Certificate (Missionary Leadership) Award is detailed in the University's General Regulations.

4.6 Study Mode

The Graduate Certificate (Missionary Leadership) is offered in External Study mode.

5 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5.1 University Admission Requirements

To be eligible for admission to The University of Notre Dame Australia, all applicants must meet the <u>University's minimum requirements for admission</u>. The requirements for admission are detailed in the University's Policy: *Admissions*.

5.2 Specific Program Requirements for Admission

To be eligible for admission to the Graduate Certificate (Missionary Leadership) applicants must meet the following additional requirements:

- 1. Have completed an AQF7 award in any field, or demonstrate at least 5 years of relevant professional experience, to be determined by the Arete Centre and the School of Philosophy and Theology.
- 2. Demonstrate that they are engaged in a form of church ministry that will form the basis of their theological reflection throughout the program
- 3. Provide a referee to the Arete Centre and be approved by the Arete Centre prior to enrolling at the University.

7 PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

7.1 Program Description

The Graduate Certificate (Missionary Leadership) grounds students with the spiritual and intellectual foundations for the exercise of different expressions of leadership in the Church, with a particular focus upon the Church's evangelising mission. The Graduate Certificate also forms students with the skills and reflective praxis required for missionary leadership. Students learn about the origins of an increasingly secularized world, and ways that Christians can respond with Christ's words and works of love. Building on theological knowledge, students also reflect their own practice of leadership, through involvement at their local parishes. This program is a unique opportunity to grow in intellectual formation and in communal appreciation of what comprises Christian leadership in a mission context.
