

Information for Education students wishing to transfer to the School of Arts & Sciences

Which Education units can be credited towards a degree in the School of Arts & Sciences?

If you are an Education student and you are thinking about changing to a degree in the School of Arts & Sciences, you should contact the School of Arts & Sciences (Sydney.artssciences@nd.edu.au) to request a meeting with one of their Deans or Course Coordinators.

At the meeting, the Dean or Course Coordinator will help to identify which of your completed Education units may be able to count towards a degree in the School of Arts & Sciences, depending on (1) your own individual circumstances, (2) the Arts & Sciences degree you would like to do, e.g. a Bachelor of Arts or a Bachelor of Communications and Media, and (3) university regulations.

****Important Note:** Students should be aware that in the School of Arts & Sciences, no more than ten 100-level units may be counted towards a degree. This may limit the number of completed Education units than can be credited towards a degree in the School of Arts & Sciences.
