GUARDIAN CONSENT FORM

Consent from a parent/legal guardian is required for applicants who will be under the age of 17 at the time of commencement:

By signing this Guardian Consent Form, I am indicating that I am the applicant's parent or legal guardian and I understand, acknowledge and agree that:

- The nature of some courses of study at The University of Notre Dame Australia may have mature or sensitive material appropriate for an adult audience. Content may include adult themes such as violence, substance use, sexual references and coarse language. I provide permission for the applicant to undertake such courses of study.
- 2. The applicant will be immersed in an adult learning environment. I shall remain primarily responsible for the applicant's personal supervision and welfare. For this purpose, I understand that I must consider whether there is a need to provide any continuing personal supervision.
- 3. The University shall not have parental responsibility and shall not be liable for any acts or omissions by the applicant. I am responsible for the actions of the applicant while they are studying at the University, and I take full responsibility for any damage done to University property by the applicant.
- 4. I shall be responsible for ensuring that the applicant adheres to the University's policies, rules and regulations. In particular, I will advise the applicant that they may not consume or purchase alcohol at student events.
- 5. If the applicant has not applied for or has not been granted a government HELP loan, I must act as guarantor for any fees incurred by the Student together with any other sums owed to the University until the student reaches 18 years of age.
- 6. The University shall not determine the suitability of or monitor or supervise the applicant's attendance and participation in on and off-campus extracurricular activities including those activities organised and conducted by the Student Association and Student Clubs and Societies. This is the responsibility of the applicant in consultation with the parent/guardian.
- 7. Unless the applicant provides a specific signed declaration to the contrary, the University's obligation of confidentiality is owed to the applicant and to nobody else. Accordingly, the University shall not divulge confidential information, for example about a applicant's academic progress, to a parent/guardian or anyone else without the consent of the applicant.
