



# Conditions of The Archbishop Foley Award

The Archbishop Foley Award (Award) was established to acknowledge the significant contribution of the late Archbishop William Foley to the foundation of the University. As Archbishop of Perth (1983-1991) he worked to have his dream of establishing a great Catholic university in the Archdiocese a reality. Archbishop Foley had a deep personal commitment to helping the underprivileged. For this reason the Archbishop Foley Award (Award) is presented to a Notre Dame student who has made an outstanding contribution of service to the University community. The awarding of the Archbishop Foley Award is governed by the following Conditions:

## 1. NAME OF PRIZE

The Archbishop Foley Award.

## 2. PURPOSE OF PRIZE

The Archbishop Foley Award is awarded annually to a student who has made an outstanding contribution of service to the University Community and the advancement of the Catholic mission and goals of the University.

## 3. VALUE OF PRIZE

The value of the Award is \$1,000 per annum.

## 4. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for this Award, a student must:

- a) Be a student of The University of Notre Dame Australia, Fremantle Campus;
- b) Have made an outstanding contribution of service; and
- c) Have shown commitment to the advancement of the Catholic mission and goals of the University.

## 5. SELECTION COMMITTEE

The successful recipient will be selected based on the advice and recommendations of a selection committee comprising:

- a) The Vice Chancellor (or nominee);
- b) Executive Director of Admissions and Student Services; and
- c) 2 Deans from The University of Notre Dame Australia, Fremantle Campus.

## 6. AWARDING PROCEDURE

The Award is awarded annually at The University of Notre Dame Australia, Fremantle Annual Awards Ceremony.

## 7. METHOD OF PAYMENT

The Award will be paid directly to the recipient by the University by way of direct deposit into a bank account nominated by the recipient.

## 8. CONCURRENT PRIZES

The Award may be held concurrently with other awards.

## 9. ADMINISTERING BODY

The Award is administered by the Office of University Relations and the Division of Admissions and Student Services, Fremantle.

## 10. PRIVACY

The University will collect, use, hold and disclose personal information in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Commonwealth) and the University's Privacy Policy.
