Certificate III in School Based Education Support

The Certificate III in School Based Education Support prepares students to work as a education assistant or an Aboriginal and Islander education officer in a range of educational settings.

The VET School Based Education Support team provides students with experiential, research-based, best practice skills and strategies. This enables each student to foster a sense of belonging and become an essential part of the Western Australian school community.

This program is suitable for Indigenous and non-Indigenous school leavers. Additionally, the Certificate III in School Based Education Support is an appropriate pathway for those wanting to gain employment in the education industry or current employees wanting to gain a qualification.

Program delivery and duration

The Certificate III in School Based Education Support is completed full time over 12 months, or four school terms to a maximum of two years. This qualification is made up of 15 units of competency (10 core and five elective units).



Core units

Practical experience

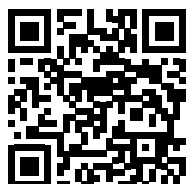
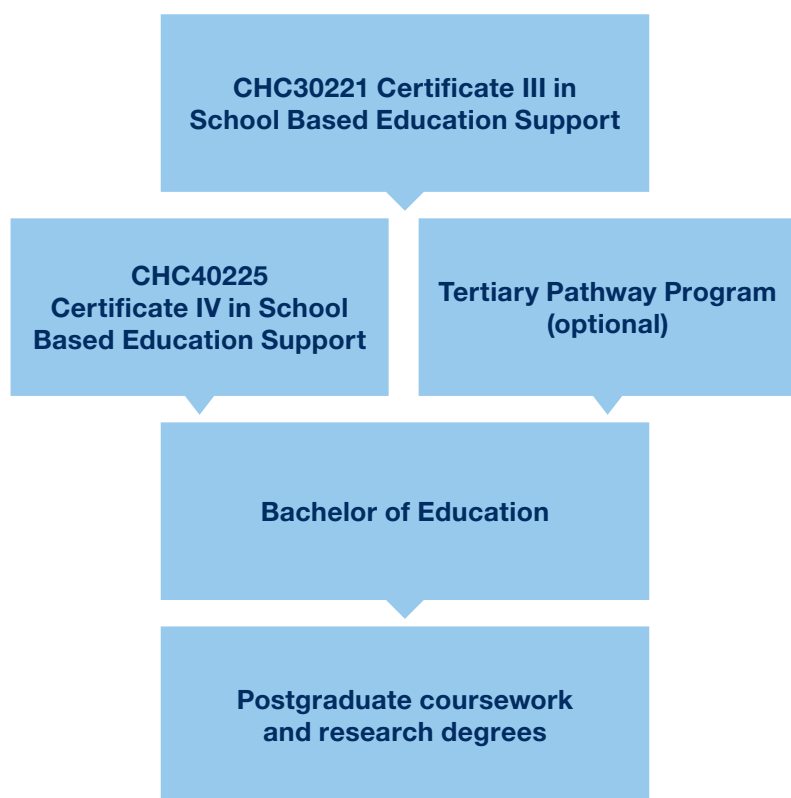

Fees and funding

State funding – Western Australia

If the student is eligible for funding, fees are as follows:

Non-concession \$1,153.44

Concession \$341.76

Youth \$341.76
