- This degree must be completed with a Communications and Media Major. The Major requires *at least* two 3000 level courses be completed, and *no more* than three 1000 level courses.
- A second Major or a Minor may also be completed.
- A maximum of 75 units of credit can be counted (including 50 units of credit to a Major) from such special courses as ARTS3800, ARTS3810, ARTS3010, ARTS3020 and ARTS3030.
