Target audience

This **introductory** workshop is suitable for staff, HDR and Honours students who would like to learn to use QSR NVivo Version 12 to manage data, analyse a research project and who have **no prior knowledge** of using NVivo.

Aim

This session is intended to give you the tools to confidently manage the analysis of your qualitative data. Qualitative data takes many forms from comments and open responses to a survey questionnaire through to in depth, narrative interview or focus group transcripts. This workshop will provide you with practical introductory guidance in managing and analysing qualitative data using QSR NVivo version 12.

The learning objectives of this workshop are to give each participant the confidence to undertake basic qualitative research analysis using QSR NVivo. This is a hands-on workshop and sample interview transcripts will be provided.

Teaching Method

Presentation, lecture, demonstration, hands-on exercises, question and answer sessions, discussions. A set of example transcripts will be provided prior to the workshop.

Learning Outcomes

Using QSR NVivo to manage and analyse your data by learning how to:

- Import files and transcripts
- Organise data for analysis
- Set up nodes and code frames
- Analyse data
- Create attributes tables and demographic information in NVivo

- Using queries and searches to produce visual outputs
- Producing reports from the coding process
