

Conditions of The Kimberley Regional Alliance for Students in Health Scholarship

The Kimberley Regional Alliance for Students in Health Scholarship (*Scholarship*) is supported by the Kimberley Regional Alliance for Students in Health (*KRASH*) and governed by the following conditions.

1. NAME OF SCHOLARSHIP

The Kimberley Regional Alliance for Students in Health Scholarship.

2. PURPOSE OF SCHOLARSHIP

The purpose of the Scholarship is to assist students enrolled in the HLT54115 Diploma of Nursing and the Bachelor of Nursing (EN Articulation Pathway) at The University of Notre Dame Australia, Broome Campus (*University*).

The Scholarship is directed towards assisting students whose educational opportunities are limited due to financial need.

3. VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIP

The value of each Scholarship is \$3,000 cash per annum. One Scholarship will be awarded to a student enrolled in the HLT54115 Diploma of Nursing and one Scholarship will be awarded to a student enrolled in the Bachelor of Nursing (EN Articulation Pathway).

4. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for consideration, applicants must:

- a) Be a current member of KRASH;
- b) Be a citizen or permanent resident of Australia;
- c) Be enrolled in the HLT54115 Diploma of Nursing or the Bachelor of Nursing (EN Articulation Pathway), Broome Campus; and
- d) Not be the subject of any current University student disciplinary process.

5. SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee for the Scholarship will comprise:

- a) The Vocational Education and Training (VET) Manager, Broome (or nominee);
- b) The Assistant Dean and Coordinator, Nursing Program, Broome (or nominee); and
- c) The Director, Majorlin Kimberley Centre for Remote Health, Broome (or nominee).

6. SELECTION CRITERIA

The Scholarship is awarded to the applicant who, in the opinion of the Selection Committee, best demonstrates through their application and supporting documentation:

- a) Financial need;
- b) Personal qualities and motivation, including how the applicant's rural experience has impacted on their determination to work in a rural or remote area; and
- c) Community service.

7. SELECTION PROCESS

- a) The Scholarship will be advertised by on the University website.
- b) Applicants will be required to submit an application to the Assistant Dean and Coordinator, Nursing Program, Broome (or nominee).
- c) Applications will be assessed by the Selection Committee.
- d) The Selection Committee may interview selected applicants.
- e) The recipients will be determined by the Selection Committee. If a unanimous decision cannot be reached in relation to any applicant, a majority decision of the Selection Committee will prevail.

8. DURATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

- a) Subject to the conditions in Clause 10 below, the Scholarship will be tenable for the equivalent of one year full time study.
- b) The Scholarship is not transferable to another degree, Notre Dame Campus or another University.

9. METHOD OF PAYMENT

- a) Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the recipient's nominated bank account.
- b) Scholarship funds to recipients enrolled in the Diploma of Nursing will be paid in three instalments, with the first instalment of \$1,000 being paid at the beginning of Stage 1, and two instalments of \$1,000 each paid at the beginning of Stage 2 and Stage 3, subject to clause 10 below.
- c) Scholarship funds to recipients enrolled in the Bachelor of Nursing will be paid in three instalments, with the first instalment of \$1,000 being paid at the beginning of Semester 1, and two instalments of \$1,000 each paid at the beginning of Semester 2 and Semester 3, subject to clause 10 below.
- d) Scholarship funds to recipients who have partially completed their studies at the time of the awarding will be distributed at the discretion of the Selection Committee.
- e) Recipients are required to complete a Gift Expenditure Form for payment of funds.

10. CONDITIONS OF CONTINUATION

Following payment of the first Scholarship instalment, payment of the second and third instalments shall be subject to the recipient:

- a) Achieving Satisfactory Academic Progress, as determined by the Assistant Dean and Coordinator, Nursing Program, Broome; and
- b) Maintaining full enrolment in the HLT54115 Diploma of Nursing or the Bachelor of Nursing (EN Articulation Pathway).

The recipient forfeits the Scholarship if they:

- a) Do not meet the requirements in 10(a) and 10(b) above;
- b) Are found to have behaved in a manner that is in breach of the University's Student Code of Conduct or are the subject of any current University student discipline process;
- c) Discontinue their Diploma or Bachelor of Nursing;
- d) Take a leave of absence or become absent without leave; or
- e) Defer their enrolment for a period greater than 12 months.

The exception to this is if the recipient makes an application in writing to the Assistant Dean and Coordinator, Nursing Program, outlining the circumstances and reasons relating to their personal situation. The Assistant Dean and Coordinator, Nursing Program, has discretion to determine the ongoing status of the Scholarship.

11. STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

Scholarship recipients are required to:

- a) Submit a mid-year and an end-of-year report to the University, outlining their progress. Reports should include academic results for the semester, an update regarding the circumstances which warrant the recipient to be in receipt of the Scholarship, and other relevant feedback. The Office of University Relations will notify the Scholarship recipient of the report submission due dates. Reports should be submitted to the Assistant Dean and Coordinator, Nursing Program; and
- b) Participate in any publications, media and events related to the award of the Scholarship.

12. ADMINISTERING BODY

The Scholarship is administered by the Office of University Relations, Fremantle.

13. PRIVACY

The University is committed to the principles contained in the Privacy Act 1988 (Commonwealth) and the Privacy Amendment (Private Sector) Act 2000 (Commonwealth) and will not disclose any personal information (as defined in the Privacy Act) relating to this Scholarship to any third party without the written consent of the applicant.

14. GENERAL PRINCIPLES

- a) These Conditions must comply with any University Regulations regarding the awarding of scholarships and prizes.
- b) The Vice Chancellor may vary the Conditions of the Scholarship at any time.
