



Conditions of The Reach Higher Grant

The Reach Higher Grant (*Grant*) has been established by the university. The Scholarship is administered in accordance with the following scholarship program conditions, and the University's [Student Scholarships Policy](#) and [Procedure](#).

1. NAME OF GRANT

Reach Higher Grant

2. PURPOSE OF GRANT

The purpose of the Scholarship is to provide financial support to assist with the cost of commencing studies, for students enrolled in any Reach Higher program, at The University of Notre Dame Australia (*University*).

3. CATEGORY OF GRANT

The scholarship will be categorised as equity, based on its core purpose and criteria.

4. VALUE OF GRANT

The value of the Scholarship will be \$2,000.

5. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for the Scholarship, applicants must:

- a) Be commencing studies as part of the Reach Higher program at any Campus of the University.
- b) Not have previously received the Reach Higher Grant.

6. SELECTION PROCESS

- a) Written applications will not be required as eligible students are automatically nominated for consideration.
- b) Selections will be made based on assessment of section 5.
- c) Recipients will be nominated in writing by the School to Student Success.
- d) Recipients will be notified via email.
- e) The University reserves the right not to award the grant.

7. DURATION OF GRANT

- a) The Grant is tenable once only, for students commencing the relevant program.
- b) The Grant is not transferable to any other organisation or institution.

8. QUANTITY OF GRANTS

The quantity of scholarships available annually will be at the discretion of the University.

9. METHOD OF PAYMENT

- a) Grant funds will be paid directly to the student as determined by the University.
- b) Recipients are required to provide payment details for payment of funds.
- c) Grant funds will be paid in one instalment.

10. STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

- a) Recipients are required to notify the University of any changes in circumstance throughout the grant term.
- b) Recipients may be invited to participate in publications, media and events related to the award of the Grant.

11. ADMINISTERING BODY

The Scholarship is administered by The University of Notre Dame Australia.

12. PRIVACY

The University is committed to the principles contained in the Privacy Act 1988 (Commonwealth) and the Privacy Amendment (Private Sector) Act 2000 (Commonwealth) and will not disclose any personal information (as defined in the Privacy Act) relating to this Scholarship to any third-party without the written consent of the applicant as obtained by the student declarations on the student application form.

The University may share personal information obtained through (the Scholarship application) with third parties where the third-party is a member of a selection committee. This information is shared for the purposes of selection only.

For reporting, the University may also share personal information for the purposes of the student meeting the recipient requirements; or where the student consents in writing to participate in publications, media and events related to the award of the Scholarship. This may include arranging for media opportunities that include the student and the third-party donor.

13. GENERAL PRINCIPLES

- a) These Conditions must comply with any University Regulations regarding the awarding of scholarships and prizes.
- b) The Vice Chancellor may vary the Conditions of the Scholarship at any time.
