be an Australian citizen or a permanent humanitarian visa holder or a New Zealand Special Category Visa holder who meets the residency requirements;

have not received an OS-HELP loan on more than one other occasion;

be enrolled with an Australian provider in a Commonwealth supported place and have completed one equivalent full-time student

load (EFTSL) - usually one year of full-time study (200 Notre Dame credits);

be studying full-time overseas and this study will count towards the program requirements for the Australian program you are enrolled in;

have at least 0.125 EFTSL (25 Notre Dame credits) of your program left to complete once you have finished your overseas study - usually one course of study;

have a valid tax file number (TFN) at the time of applying

have a Unique Student Identifier (USI) prior to the first census date (for new enrolments from 1 January 2021)

have read the OS-HELP Statement of terms and conditions.

6. SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

Confirmation of overseas study approval from program coordinator (not required for the Notre Dame Exchange Program) Letter of acceptance from host institution or placement provider (this can be sent through later if unavailable at time of application)

7. IF APPLICATION IS SUCCESSFUL

Submit a digital eCAF form online. Successful applicants will receive a link to complete this eCAF form

8. DECLARATION

declare that I have read and understood the <u>OS-HELP statement</u> terms and conditions and declare myself to be eligible for the OS-HELP Loan. I understand the OS-HELP allocation process is competitive and not all applicants who meet basic eligibility criteria are necessarily allocated loans. If my application is approved, I authorise the University of Notre Dame to make the OS-HELP payment based on the information contained in this form. I understand that after this payment is made I will be required to repay the debt even if I do not complete my studies, or if due to unforseen circumstances I do not undertake the study abroad programme approved by the University of Notre Dame.
