

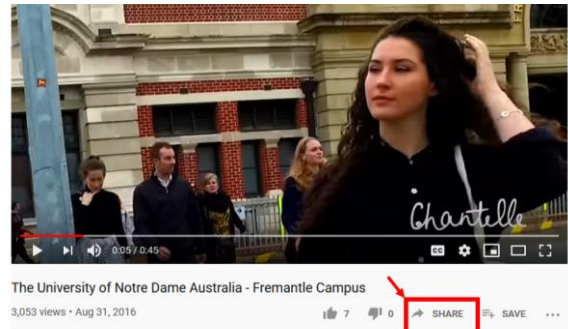
Embedding YouTube Videos in Blackboard - Students

Blackboard Quick Guide

You can embed YouTube video content in your Discussion Board posting on Blackboard to display as a player. This presentation makes it much more interesting compared to just a web link, and is very easy to do.

Please note that if this is the video that you produce yourself, you may wish to post it on YouTube as **unlisted**, so that it will not come up in search results or be listed on your channel. Only those who have a direct link will be able to view your unlisted video.

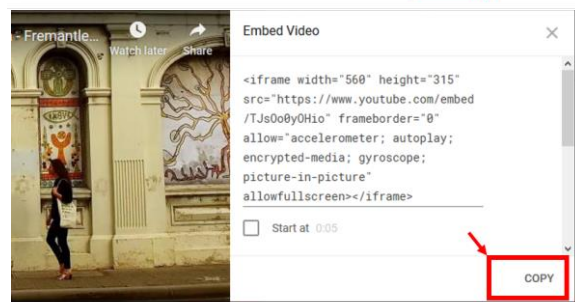
1. Open the target video in YouTube;
In the options below the video, click **Share**:



2. Click **Embed (the first listed option)**



and then click on **COPY** in the next frame:



3. Log into your course in Blackboard, navigate to the **Discussion Board**, open the **Forum** where you have to post your video and click on **"Create Thread"**;

4. Give your new message a **Subject** (e.g., the title of your video) and click on **HTML** button in the text box:



Note. If you cannot see the HTML button, click on the **Show More** button to reveal it:



5. Paste the iframe code that you copied from YouTube into this window (<Ctrl V>), then click **Update** on the bottom right and click **Submit**.
