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Distinguished Children's Health Specialist joins the Stan Perron Charitable Foundation Board

Professor Gervase Chaney has been appointed to the Board of The Stan Perron Charitable Foundation.

A fellow of the Royal Australian College of Physicians, Professor Chaney is a distinguished medical practitioner and now academic currently serving as Dean of the School of Medicine at Notre Dame University, Fremantle.

Professor Chaney has extensive professional experience in senior roles in children's health including as Executive Director Commissioning the new Perth Children's Hospital and Executive Director of Princess Margaret Hospital for Children.

Professor Chaney's current and previous board roles include the Australian Research Alliance for Children and Youth, Academy of Child and Adolescent Health, the Royal Australian College of Physicians and Kidsafe WA.
