15-week accelerated program: Fast track your career in school based education support

Our 15-week, full-time Certificate III in School Based Education Support is a high-intensity, fast-tracked program delivered in partnership with Fremantle Primary School. Designed for individuals with prior experience in education, childcare, disability or individual support settings, this program offers an immersive and practice-aligned training experience.

This program is not a gentle introduction – it's designed for motivated learners who are ready to commit to a high workload, a fast-paced training schedule and a structured pathway into school-based roles.

Over 15 weeks, you will

- ✓ Attend full-time training:
 - Monday, Wednesday and Friday onsite at Notre Dame's Fremantle Campus
 - Tuesday and Thursday on work placement at Fremantle Primary School.
- ✓ Gain practical workplace skills to support students across primary and secondary school settings.
- ✓ Complete a nationally recognised qualification with no extensions available.
- ✓ Transition quickly into school-based employment as an Education Assistant or Learning Support Assistant.

This program is best suited to people who

- ✓ Are already working in people-focused industries (such as childcare, disability support or community services).
- ✓ Can manage a fast-paced study environment with high expectations.
- ✓ Are seeking a clear and supported career change into education support.

With strong industry partnerships and experienced trainers and assessors, you will graduate with the confidence and skills to make a meaningful impact in the classroom.

Program delivery and duration

The Certificate III in School Based Education Support is completed full time over 15 weeks. This qualification is made up of 15 units of competency (10 core and five elective units).

Practical experience

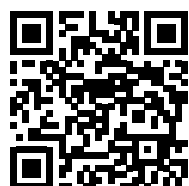
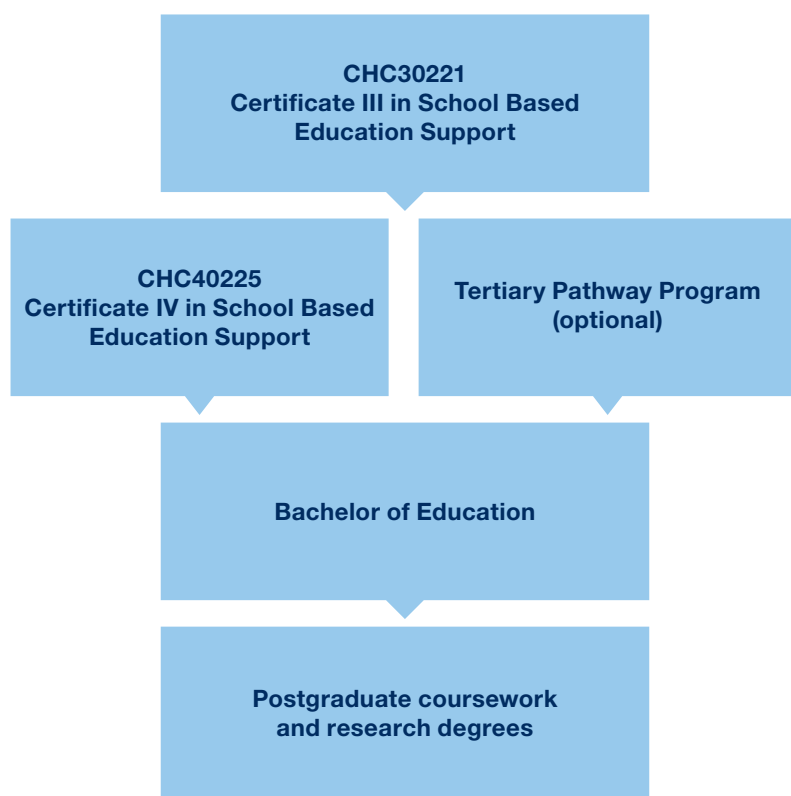
As part of this program students will complete a minimum of 100 hours of work placement in a classroom setting at Fremantle Primary School. Work experience provides valuable insight into the teaching profession and hands-on learning, with the opportunity to meet potential employers.

Career opportunities

Upon successful completion of Certificate III in School Based Education Support, students are eligible to work in a diverse range of educational environments, such as primary and secondary schools and school-aged care.

Fees and funding

State funding – Western Australia

If the student is eligible for funding, fees are as follows:

Non-concession \$1,153.44

Concession \$341.76

Youth \$341.76
