### Obtaining your Student ID card

All students should obtain an ID card. Not only is this the preferred form of ID to be used in examinations, your Student ID also allows you to borrow resources from the library and pay for printing on campus. As the card identifies you as a university student, you can use it to access student discounts and public transport concessions. The Student Admin team can take your photo and issue you with your Student ID card once you are on campus.

### How to Log in

As a student at Note Dame, you will receive access to a number of systems, all of which have the same default login details:

**Username:** Your ID number

**Password:** 'Nd' (for Notre Dame) followed by your date of birth 'ddmmyyyy'

*(e.g. If your birthday is 13 July 2001, your password will be Nd13072001)*

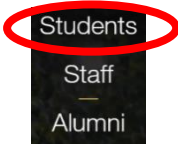
# Enrolling in Classes via Student Centre

Most applications are available through MyND Portal, however, this is the easiest way to access the Student Centre (where you will complete your enrolment today):

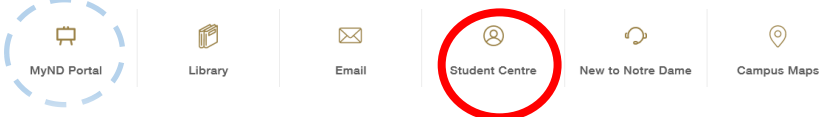
1. Go to the University website [www.notredame.edu.au](http://www.notredame.edu.au)
2. Select the triple bar icon on the top right corner of the home page



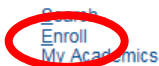
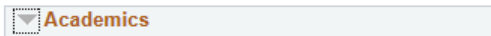
3. Select 'Students'



4. Select Student Centre



5. Select the <https://mycampus.nd.edu.au> link under 'Access'
6. Log in using the credentials listed above
7. Select the 'Student Centre' tile
8. Select "Enrol"



9. Select "Add", choose the relevant Study Period and press [Continue]
10. Enter the first 'Class No.' from the previous page and press [Enter]
11. Check that the Course No. and Course Name are correct and press [Next]
12. Repeat steps 10 and 11 until all of the courses you are enrolling in for this study period appear in your 'Shopping Cart'
13. Press [Proceed to Step 2 of 3]
14. Double check that the information is correct and when satisfied press [Finish Enrolling]
15. Confirm that all classes have a green tick next to them
16. Review the enrollments in [My Class Schedule]
17. Once you have completed your enrolment, simply 'Sign out' of Student Centre (on the triple bar icon)
