Certificate IV in School Based Education Support

The CHC40221 Certificate IV in School Based Education Support qualification prepares learners to work as a Teacher Assistant (TA) or an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Teacher's Assistant (ATA) in a range of educational settings. The VET School Based Education Support team provides learners with experiential, research-based, best practice skills, and strategies. This enables the learner to foster a sense of belonging and become an essential part of the WA school community.

This program is suitable for Indigenous and non-Indigenous school leavers. Additionally, the CHC40221 Certificate IV in School Based Education Support is an appropriate pathway for those wanting to gain employment in the education industry or current employees wanting to gain a qualification.

Course delivery and duration

The CHC40221 Certificate IV in School Based Education Support is part time and completed over 18 months (6 school terms) to a maximum of 2 years. This qualification is made up of 17 units of competency (13 core and 4 elective units).
