Preparing for Professional Practicum (Fremantle)

Preparing for prac includes submission of mandatory items (collectively known as Prac Pack).

Submission of the Prac Pack is a requirement for health care workers as advised by the Western Australian Department of Health (DoH).

It is mandatory that nursing students provide evidence of vaccination or immunity against vaccine-preventable diseases prior to attending clinical practicum.

Each student must also submit evidence of criminal screenings and annual certifications.

Students will not be eligible for prac until a complete Prac Pack is successfully submitted.

Students will be expected to attend early, late and night shifts across the seven-day week.

Placements **may not** be available close to home, and it will be the student's responsibility to organise travel arrangements.

It is essential that holidays or other arrangements are not organised until placements have been confirmed.

It is an expectation that Notre Dame Bachelor of Nursing students will:

- Review inherent requirements and complete declarations with honesty.
- Comply with the immunisation standards of this profession as guided by the DoH Health Care Worker Immunisation Policy to protect students, employees, and patients from potential threat of exposure to vaccine preventable diseases.
- Declare any criminal history prior to their enrolment in the program.
- Be physically and mentally fit to practice all nursing skills.

Hepatitis B: Evidence of recent dose or proof of immunity.
