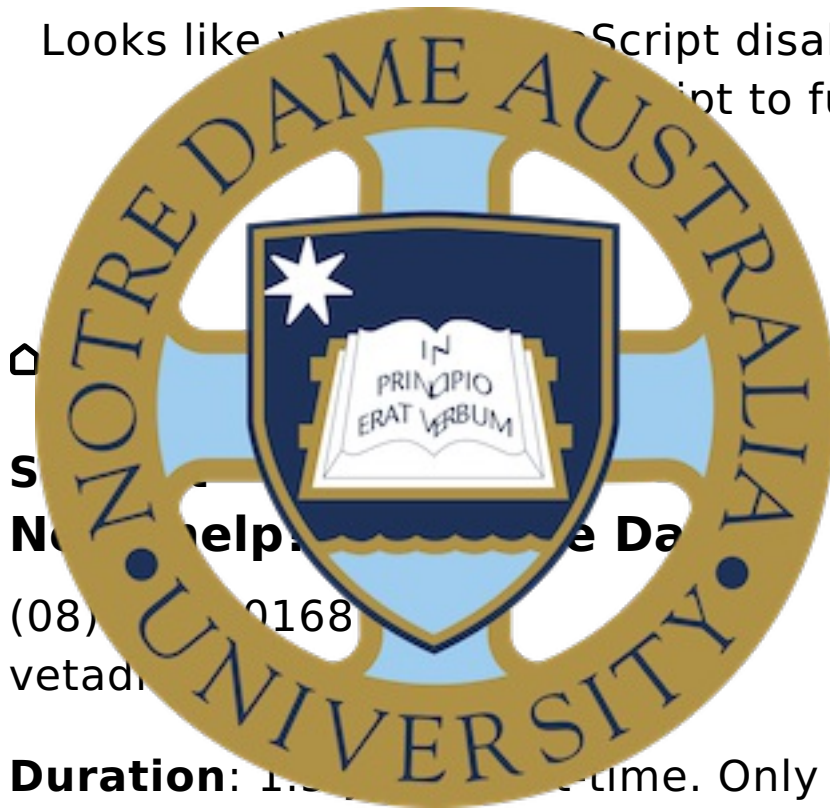

This qualification is ideal for people wanting to keep their options open for the type of education environment they would like to work in the future. After completing this qualification, job opportunities include Teaching Assistant in schools, preschools/kindergartens; Education Assistant in special needs, language/literacy, cultural support; School Aged Care Assistant; and Home Tutor.

During this program, you will gain the skills and knowledge to support children's development and learning within a curriculum framework, manage behaviour, work effectively with children with special needs, identify children at risk, and follow legal and ethical frameworks, including child protection and policies.

This program is delivered face to face on Notre Dame's Broome Campus and at school and community locations throughout the Kimberley and is full-time over 18 months. You will be required to complete 17 units of competency, 12 core units and five electives, to be awarded a CHC40221 Certificate IV in School Based Education Support qualification.

This program is suitable for school leavers or other interested persons wanting to gain employment in the education sector and current employees in the education sector wishing to qualify.

This course is subsidised by Jobs and Skills WA for people living in the Kimberley region of Western Australia. Please note that access to subsidised training is subject to availability.
