## **Entry requirements**

Notre Dame encourages applications from people of all backgrounds and takes into consideration the applicant's academic performance as well as their personal qualities and accomplishments. Academic requirements are as follows:

- A recognised undergraduate degree (or equivalent qualification) or studies sufficient to meet the requirements of that Award; or
- A Graduate Certificate in a Business discipline; or
- Where the applicant does have an undergraduate degree, the Dean may approve admission to this program if the

Dean is satisfied that: a) the applicant has sufficient background and/or experience in

management/supervision; and b) the applicant has the skills necessary to complete postgraduate studies.

#### **Domestic Fee-Paying**

A domestic fee-paying place is a place at university where the student is responsible for the full cost the program. Eligible domestic fee-paying students may apply for the <u>FEE-HELP loan scheme</u> (https://www.studyassist.gov.au/previewlink/node/108/a39069a0-c0d9-4ed5-ad8e-1df4d43a987a) which assists eligible fee-paying students with the payment of all, or part, of their tuition fees, not including additional study costs such as accommodation or textbooks. Your FEE-HELP debt will be indexed each year in line with the Consumer Price Index.

#### **International Full-Fee Paying**

Tuition costs depend on an international student's study load and discipline. Fees are payable each semester at least four weeks prior to the commencement of your program.
