The program encourages you to develop your educational practice in both clinical and non-clinical environments. This degree is flexible because we understand that clinical educators often have multiple priorities – some of which include patient care, supervision, teaching, research and development, management, and administration. The courses that make up this qualification are delivered online, allowing content to be accessed at a time, place, and pace that best suits you.

- Active involvement in health professional education

Students who have completed a Graduate Certificate in Learning and Teaching for Higher Education or equivalent may be eligible to enrol in the Graduate Diploma of Health Professional Education.

- Examine learning theories underpinning educational practice and scholarship and apply them effectively within the health education context
- 2. Analyse contemporary issues within health professional education and their significant influence on the

3. Engage in reflective practice to promote life-long learning.
