Creative Non-Fiction Writing Short Course

Finding new ways to write your experiences

This course examines how creative non-fiction uses literary techniques to produce factually accurate narratives. It includes an analysis of narrative and non-narrative literary forms such as biography, history, memoir, and the personal essay. Students produce an extended piece of writing in their chosen non-fiction genre.

Course Structure

This course will be delivered entirely online with weekly interactive seminars held in the evenings over the thirteen-week semester.

This course can be taken on its own or as part of a postgraduate degree.

Course Outcomes

At the completion of this course a student should be able to:

- Analyse concepts and processes in the field of non-

fiction writing

- Evaluate industry contexts and platforms for the publication of non-fiction work
- Create a substantial piece of non-fiction writing
- Analyse his/her and other students' non-fiction work
