Undergraduate Certificate in Foundations of Education

School of Education

The Undergraduate Certificate in Foundations of Education offers students the opportunity to experience University-level studies in teaching. Students will explore the ideas and approaches to learning that form a base from which to progress to a Bachelor of Education.

Why study this certificate?

An Undergraduate Certificate in Foundations of Education provides an opportunity to critically examine a range of issues that impact learning, and introduces students to principles relating to pedagogy, assessment and student motivation. Students will also develop key foundational skills in Mathematics and Numeracy, as well as learn how to research and analyse critical issues, and present information and arguments.

The Undergraduate Certificate in Foundations of Education is designed for students who:

- Would like to start their pathway to becoming a teacher in NSW
- Are returning to or entering university and want to trial whether they would like to proceed with further study in the field of Education
- Want to articulate into a Bachelor degree (provided minimum requirements are met)

Program summary

The Undergraduate Certificate in Foundations of Education consists of four compulsory courses.

- EDUC1004 Academic Skills
- EDUC1006 Learning and Development
- EDUC1016 Mathematics and Numeracy
- EDUC1009 English, Language and Literacy

Please note that although this certificate is delivered wholly online, the Bachelor of Primary Education, Bachelor of Secondary Education require attendance on the Sydney campus.
